# ACTIVITY GUIDE



'Channel 6' is an exhibition by Jennifer Martin.

Jennifer Martin has been thinking about power, being unsafe and immigration.

Immigration is when people move from one country to live in a different one.

If you are new to a country, you can apply for permission to live there as long as you like. In the UK, this permission is called 'leave to remain'.

The group of people in charge of deciding if you are allowed 'leave to remain' in the UK are called the Home Office.

If the Home Office decide that you are not allowed 'leave to remain', life can get very difficult, and the things you need to feel safe can get taken away.

You might not be able to get help finding work, somewhere to sleep or even money for food.

This can happen to adults and their children, even if the children were born in the UK and have never left.

Channel 6 lets us look inside the Home Office, a place where powerful people make decisions about who is allowed to live in the UK.

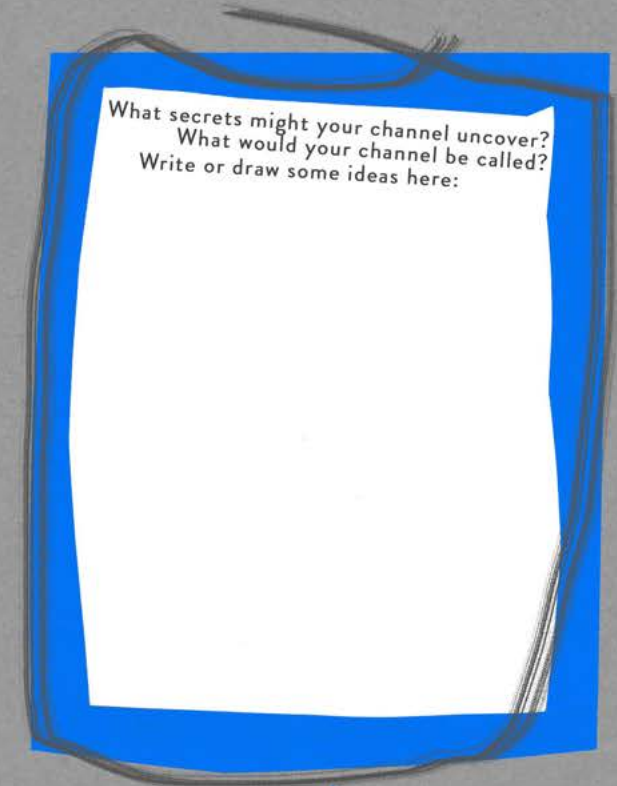
Some things that happen here are secret, and people aren't allowed to see inside.

Imagine you could create a TV channel that lets you see inside somewhere that is usually top secret.

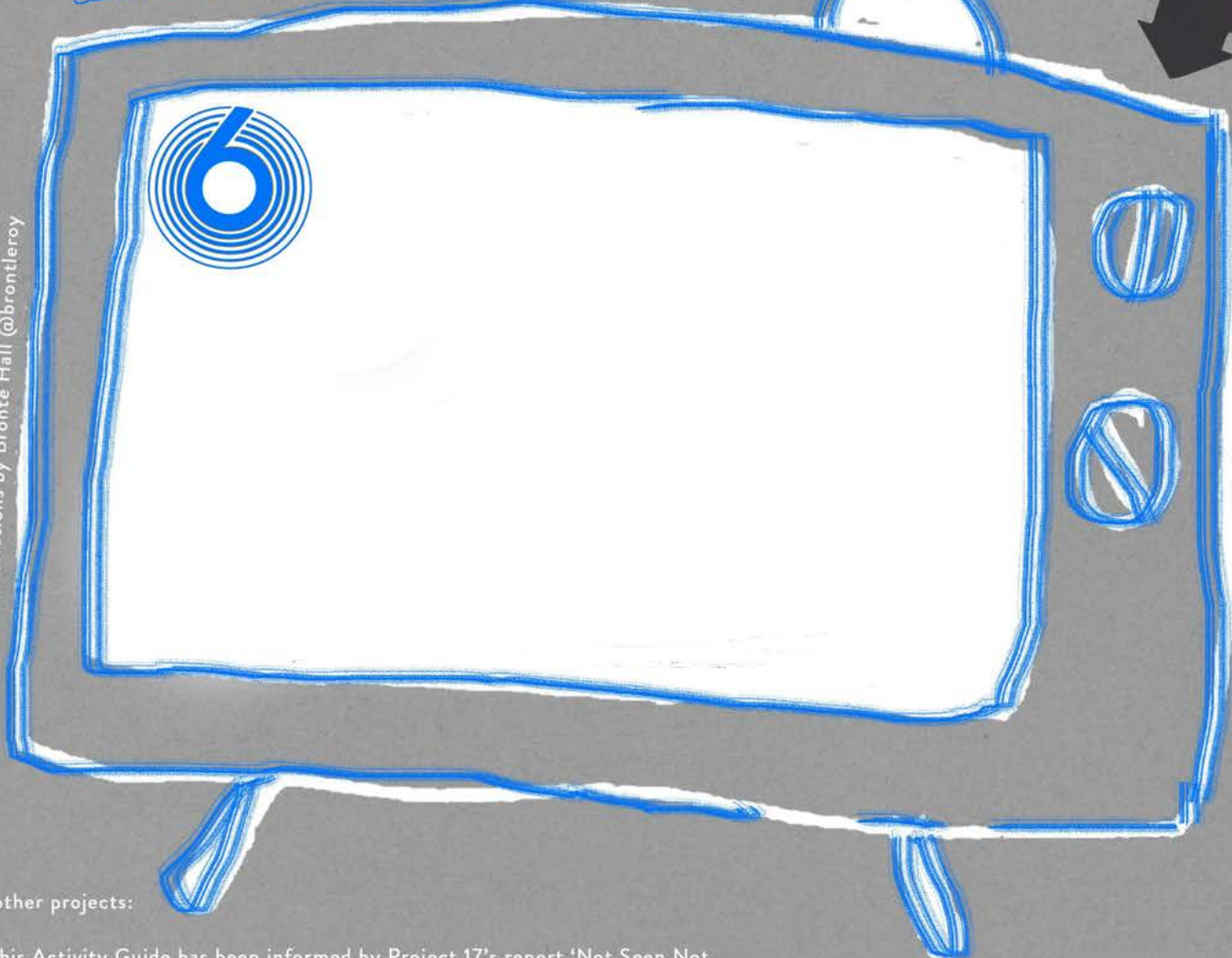
It might be a place where people in charge make decisions. Or where things are hidden.
