Many, including Heathfield House, fall into disrepair without viable uses. Heritage space is at risk in Croydon.

15 of Croydon's listed heritage spaces are currently on Historic England's 'at risk' register.

How? Heathfield House

- Artist studios, targeted to local undersupported, disabled
 & emerging artists. Operated on a licence membership
 model as Turf is a registered charity, income is non-profit.
- Ground floor; Flexible use will allow the space to be used for events for a stable model, plus a public programme of projects, and activities from the longstanding Croydon Ecology Centre.
- Potential to introduce **sculpture & art trails** in the grounds, subject to Council agreement.

How? Heathfield House

- Rent offered after an initial rent-free period.
- Space improvements fundraised & organised by Turf.
- Studio members to help to care for grounds in exchange for low studio fees, in collaboration with the Ecology Centre.
- Additional income from events hire.
